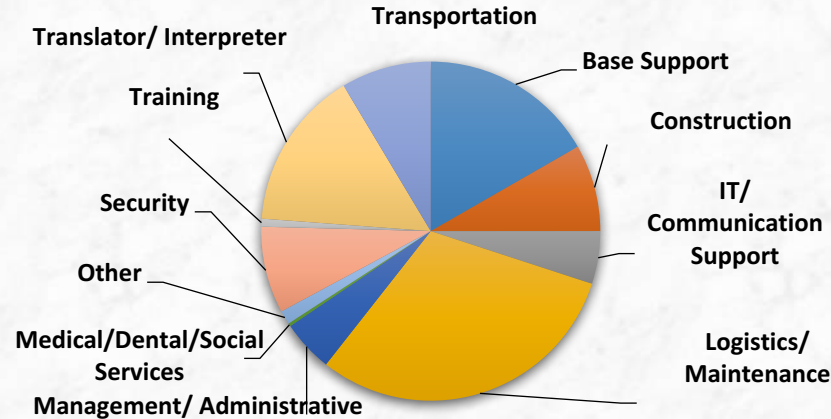

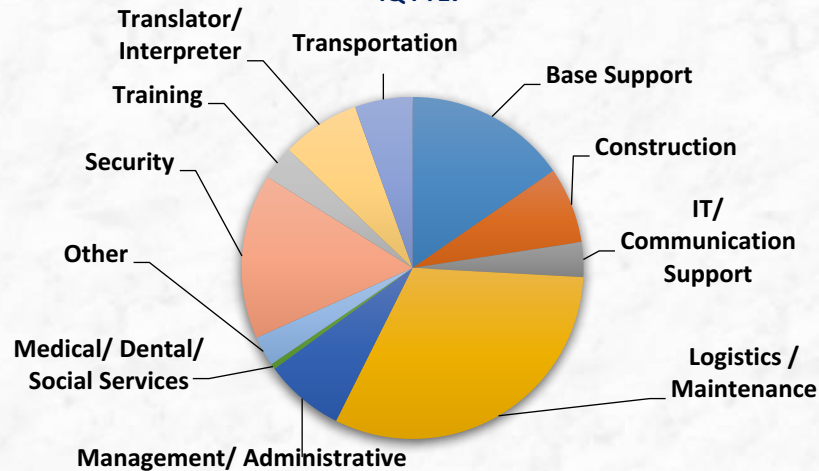
## Contractors by Mission Area (Iraq): 4,609
